Dear Friends,

Clerk's Corner

The Session of First Presbyterian Church, Pasadena, Texas, met in a stated meeting on Monday, January 13, 2025, in the Fellowship Hall.

The following action items were taken.

- The session approved holding a prayer vigil to pray for our church on March 7, 2025, from 6:00 p.m. to March 8 at 6:00 p.m.
- The session approved holding a spaghetti dinner on February 15 at 6:00 p.m. and to ask for donations to cover expenses.
- Marvin Clark was elected to serve as treasurer with Roy Kreitz and Brett Coe as back-up.
- Brett Coe was elected as the trustee for the class of 2027.
- Roy Kreitz (chair), Brett Coe, and Laura Phipps were elected to serve on the Personnel Committee.
- Betsy Marlow (chair) and Nancy Saldivar were elected to serve as the session representatives on the Congregational Nominating Committee for 2025.
- The session approved minutes of the stated session meeting on November 18, 2024, and the called session meeting on January 5, 2025.
- The session approved Angelina Theresa Walmsley's request to be removed from membership.
- The session approved the use of The Day I Met Jesus by Frank Viola for the Current Christianity class.
- The session approved the use of The Four Priorities by Dr. John Tolson and Larry Kreider for study by the youth.
- The session approved having the youth collect an offering as part of the Souper Bowl of Caring on February 9 with the collection going to Pasadena Community Ministries.
- The session approved holding the Special Summer Event on June 9, 10, and 11.
- The session approved the 2025 budget.

The following reports were given.

- The current membership is 192.
- Brett reported that last year's income was \$434, 557.56, which included grants from Presbytery and moving \$65,000 from savings to checking account. Expenses were \$414,058.58. The expenses for the year exceeded pledged and other income for the year.
- Brett reported that the windows in the church, including the sanctuary, stained-glass window, have been caulked and cleaned. The ceiling tiles above the stained-glass window have been replaced.
